DON

(beat)

Okay. I've heard two competing stories. One from a very credible woman who as far as I can see has no reason to lie. The other from a guy I judge to be a little sketchy who has every reason to lie. And I'm obligated to believe the sketchy guy.

MARY

This isn't a courtroom, you're not legally obligated to presume innocence.

DON

I believe I'm morally obligated.

MARY

(pause)

You know you're a good guy but do people tell you a lot that your head's up your ass?

DON

They do. And I absolutely allow for that possibility. I'm the guy who goes around saying O.J.'s not guilty because a jury said so.

MARY

I'm not gonna get a jury.

DON

I know and I can imagine how frustrating that must--

MARY

No you can't imagine.

DON

I can't.

(beat)

But it's a huge, dangerous, ominous, scary-as-shit mistake to convene your own trial in front of a television audience. Where there's no due process, no lawyers, no discovery, no rules of procedure, decisions on admissable evidence, threat of perjury, confrontation of witnesses or any of the things we do--

MARY

--to ensure that rapists go to Stanford Medical School.

DON

To ensure that an innocent person isn't destroyed. The law will acquit him, but the Internet never will.

MARY

I'm not a vigilante.

DON

Mary--

MARY

When you came in here you wanted to go to a public place because you were scared I'd cry rape. I'm scared of getting raped. I'm scared all the time. All the time. So you know what my site does? It scares you. It scares the living shit out of any guy who thinks even once about putting his hands on someone without an invitation.

DON

You're right to name your attacker. You may even be obligated to. But the site's gonna clobber an innocent person, there's no chance it won't. And if you face off with the guy you've accused on TV it's gonna be a lawless food fight with irreversible, irretrievable consequences. Teams will be formed, you will be slut-shamed and you won't get the justice you're looking for. That's why I'm asking you to refuse.
